

Tournament Host Guidelines
December 3, 2006

A Tournament Host draw will be conducted to determine the following Host Teams for each of the Tucson ASA Tournaments. All teams returning for their 2nd Year will be eligible for the Draw.

Fence/Phone Host (Lincoln or Golf Links)

Set up and Take down Portable fencing on 4 fields at assigned Complex
Contact assigned local teams to determine entries in tournament

Refund of Tournament Entry Fee + \$200

Field Prep/Score Tracking Host

Field Prep: Install temporary pitching rubbers, groom batters boxes, pitching mounds and around bases after every game, drag & line fields after every two games, water when necessary. Also responsible for assisting team check in and collecting, distributing game balls and posting scores.

Refund of Tournament entry fee + \$400

Teams will be given 1st option to provide 3 Person Crew's (16 Years or Older) as required to assist the Concession Stand as scheduled by Tucson Invitational Games Inc. A Donation of \$20 per Hour will be made available to Teams.

Remaining Used game balls will be distributed amongst the host teams.

Fund raising opportunities from the March, Tucson Invitational Games Inc. will be made available for Local Teams. If team has not registered yet, Funds will be held in escrow and applied to their Registration fees.

One Team, February 24th, 2007: Take Fences from Storage Unit & Set up at Lincoln Park (4 fields): \$150

March 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24

Teams of 3 people are needed for afternoon & evening shifts at the Tucson Invitational Games Inc. Duties may include snack bar, gate attendant, merchandise sales, or field maintenance. A Donation of \$20 per hour per 3 person team will be available to teams.
